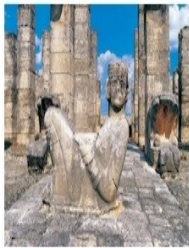

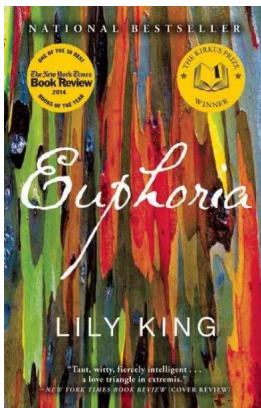


Mother Goose is on the Loose!

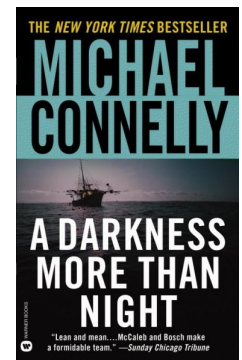

DOWNLOAD TO ANDROID SMARTPHONE/TABLET

Use these instructions for nookColor, Nook Tablets, and Kindle Fire.

1. Download Overdrive Media Console from Google Play Store.
2. Click **Free** and then click **Install App**.
3. Your first time you will be asked to sign up for an Overdrive account.
4. Overdrive will ask for name, email address, and a password.
5. To borrow find your library or tap **Add a library** as shown on left.
6. You can click the star next to NOBLE to save the Library.
7. You can click the library system you saved in My Libraries List.
8. Sign in with library card as shown above left.
9. Search for the book you want and click on **Borrow** as shown on left.
10. Click **Download**, select EPUB ebook.
11. Click **Confirm & Download**.
12. Downloaded titles can be found at BOOKSHELF as shown above.

DOWNLOAD TO KINDLE DEVICE OR KINDLE APP WITH OVERDRIVE

1. Download Kindle app at Google Play.
2. Go to Overdrive.noblenet.org
3. Sign in as shown on left hand side below.
4. Search for book as shown on right hand side.
5. Click **Q** to retrieve book.
6. Click on **Borrow**.
7. Choose Download to appropriate device.
8. Click **Kindle Book**.
9. Click **Confirm & get Kindle Book**.
10. Kindle will take you to Amazon. In right hand corner of page find **Get library book**.
11. Click **Get library book**. You may need to sync your device.

DOWNLOAD TO IOS DEVICE

Apple devices including iPad, iPhone, and iPhone Touch.

1. Download Overdrive Media Console from **App Store**.
2. Click **Free** and then click **Install App**. You will need your apple password.
3. Your first time you will be asked to sign up for an Overdrive account.
4. Overdrive will ask for name, email address, and a password.
5. To borrow find your library or tap **Add a library** as shown on left.
6. You can click the Snootham library to save the Library.
7. You can click the library system NOBLE you saved in My Libraries List.
8. Sign in with library card as shown above left.
9. Search for the book you want and click on **Borrow** as shown on left.
10. Click **Download**, select EPUB ebook.
11. Click **Confirm & Download**.
12. Downloaded titles can be found at BOOKSHELF as shown above.
