

### Craig O'Neill is artist of the month










Mystery Book Club September 5th at 7PM

#### **Strategic Planning for the Library**



We are in the midst of planning for the next five years!

The Board of Trustees and I hired Barbara Alevras of Sage Consulting to assist us. Thus far, we have completed the survey portion of the process. Thank you to everyone who filled out the survey! The results will be part of the final plan, due to be completed in October.

September will be a busy month for the planning process. We will be having a total of five meetings!

1 and 2. One SOAR meeting for Trustees and Friends of the Library and one SOAR meeting for staff. A SOAR exercise is used to analyze current and future conditions that affect the Library and its ability to provide services it deems necessary. It identifies the Library's key Strengths, Opportunities, Aspirations, and Results


3 There will be a Community Visioning meeting. A Community Visioning exercise is a group brainstorming exercise in which participants envision what an ideal Stoneham community is. The goal is to develop a list of Community Vision Statements that capture the ideal Stoneham's key Characteristics and offerings, with the Library as a central / key component.

4 and 5 There will be two focus group meetings. Focus groups generally are small groups of people focused in discussing more specific topics, in this case, the Library.

Both the Community Visioning meeting and the focus groups are limited in size, to ensure those participating have ample time to express and discuss ideas. If you have any questions about this process or if you may be interested in attending a meeting, please let me know!
